1422 GIARRUSO (1789Wallace x 1409 Miller)

This year...For our annual Club Seed contest, we have chosen an absolute *Brute of a Pumpkin*. We chose for you, the 1422.5 Giarruso. Take a good long look at this pumpkin and then consider its genetics. It came from a 1789 Wallace and was pollinated by the 1409 Miller. These same seeds are in the 1872 Wallace. It contains the best of both worlds. Eddy grew it on Prudence Island which is located out in Narragansett Bay, and hauled it to shore on the Prudence Island Ferry. It was weighed at Frerichs Farm this year, and was 2% heavy to chart. Eddy's email is egro5@msn.com

In order to be eligible you must be the grower, and a member of the SNGPG.

You can pollinate with whatever seed you want but the female must be the 1422.5 Giarruso.

Your pumpkin must also have been entered in an official weigh-off in 2013, and it must meet the GPC criteria for a sound pumpkin.
